

The chart displays wave height in meters on the y-axis (0 to 12) and dates on the x-axis (Thu 20-Nov to Sun 30-Nov). A vertical red dashed line at the start of the period indicates the beginning of the forecast. The bars are color-coded by forecast accuracy: green for 'Excellent', blue for 'Very Good', purple for 'Good', yellow for 'Poor', red for 'Noise', and black for 'Unknown'. The wave height starts high (around 10.5m) on Thursday, drops to around 9.5m on Friday, and then fluctuates between 8m and 10m until Sunday.
